Vocabulary Lesson 2 of 3: **yimmi** – to believe

Ish i yimmi ha?

Did you believe him/her?

Keyu, ak i yimmo tuk.

No, I did not believe him/her.

Keyu, i sʋ yimmi tuk kiyo.

No, I did not believe him/her.

Word Meaning: **ak** (ahk) = I not **sʋ** (sah) = I

ish (esh) = you **i** (e^{hn}) = to or for him/her/it

yimmi (yihm-mih) = to believe **keyu** (key-yoh) = no

yimo (yihm-o) = not believe **kiyo** (key-yoh) = not

tuk (tohk)/ **ha** (h^{ahn}) = past tense marker
