

Lesson of The Day

Vocabulary : **hvpiba/ hvpibai** – with us all

hvpiba = used before verbs that begin with a *consonant*

hvpibai = used before verbs that begin with a *vowel*

Okla hvpiba taloa ch̄i.

The people will sing with us all.

Miko vt hvpibai impa tuk.

The Chief ate with us all.

Word Meaning:

hvpiba (ha-pih-bah)/ **hvpibai** (hv-pih-bye) = with us all

okla (ohk-lah) = people **vt** (aht) = subject marker

miko (m^{ehn}-ko) = chief **taloa** (tah-loh-wah) = sing

achi (ah-ch^{ehn}) = future tense marker (the ‘**a**’ is in the preceding word ‘**taloa**’)

impa (ehm-pah) = to eat

tuk (tohk) = past tense marker
