Noun: abeka aiasha - hospital

Svshki yvt abeka aiasha ia tuk.

My mother went to the hospital.

Pim abeka aiasha yvt Talihina hikia.

Our hospital is in Talihina.

Word Meaning: **svshki** (sahsh-ke) = my mother

yvt (yaht) = subject marker

ia (e-yah) = go/ going

abeka aiasha (ah-be-kah eye-yah-sha) = hospital

tuk (tohk) = past tense marker

pim (pehm) = our

hikia (he-k^{ehn}-yah) = standing (in this context **hikia** is loosely translated as 'located there')
