Vocabulary: **Chahta anumpa** – Choctaw language

Chahta anumpa ya ish anumpula hinla ho?

Can you speak the Choctaw language?

Chahta anumpa yvt pi kania nna.

Let us not lose the Choctaw language.

Word Meaning: **Chahta** (chah-tah) = Choctaw

anumpa (ah-nohm-pa) = language/word

yvt (yaht) = subject marker **ya** (y^{ahn}) = object marker

ish (esh) = you **anumpula** (ah-nohm-poh-la) = speak

pi (p^{ihn}) = to or for us **kania** (kah-ne-yah) = lose

hinla (hihn-la) = can **ho** (h^{ohn}) = question marker

nna (nah) = not (follows command to negate)
