Vocabulary: **hokchi** – to plant (seeds, plants)

Svpok tek vt na pakanli hokchi bvna.

My granddaughter wants to plant flowers.

Iti aiena ka hokchi bvna hosh makachi tuk.

She said she also wants to plant a tree.

Word Meaning:

tek (teek) = female

svpok (sah-pohk) = my grandchild

vt (aht) = subject marker

na pakanli (nah pah-kahn-lih) = flower(s)

hokchi (hohk-che) = to plant

bvna (bahn-nah) = want

iti (ih-tih) = tree

hosh (hohsh) = to

aiena (eye-nah) = also

ka (kahn) = a

makachi (mah-kah-che) = to say

tuk (tohk) = past tense marker
