<mark>Ilvppvt kvta immi</mark>?

Whose is this?

Yvmmvt chimmi.

That belongs to you.
or
That is yours.

Word Meaning: chimmi (chim-meh) = yours

ilvppvt (ih-lahp-paht) = subject marker (this, these)

yvmmvt (yahm-maht) = subject marker (that, those)

kvta (kah-ta) = who

immi (ehm-me) = his; hers; it's; theirs
