Possessive pronoun: **immi** - his, hers, its, theirs

Ilvppvt kvta immi?

Whose is this?

Yvmmvt vlla immi.

That is the child's

or

That belongs to the child.

Word Meaning: **immi** (ehm-me) = his; hers; theirs

ilvppvt (ih-lahp-paht) = subject marker (this, these)

yvmmvt (yahm-maht) = subject marker (that, those)

kvta (kah-ta) = who

vlla (ahl-la) = child
