Vocabulary: vno akosh – I, the one who...initiates an action with li

Ūno akosh tvmaha ia la chi.

Con conversationally: **Anakosh tvmaha ia la chi.**

I am the one who will go to town.

Ūno akosh shulush himona chompa li tuk.

Con conversationally: **Anakosh shulush himona chompa li tuk.**

I am the one who bought new shoes.

Word Meaning:

vno akosh (ah-noh ah-kohsh) = I, the one who...initiates an action with **li**

Con conversationally: **anakosh** (ah-nah-kohsh)

tvmaha (tah-mah-ha) = town

ia (e-yah) = to go **li** (lih)/ **la** (lah) = I (**li** changes to **la** for future tense **achi**)

achi (ah-ch^{ehn}) = future tense

shulush (shoh-lohsh) = shoes

himona (hih-moh-nah) = new

chompa (chohm-pah) = buy

tuk (tohk) = past tense

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
