Vocabulary: **nusupi** – oak (tree)

**Nusupi ma malvtha yvt isso tuk.**

That oak was struck by lightning.

**Mafo yvt nusupi illi ma bvshli cha hokmi.**

Grandfather is cutting and burning that dead oak.

**Word Meaning: ma** (mahn) = that

**nusupi** (noh-sah-pih) = oak

**malvtha** (mah-laht-ha) = lightning

**yvt** (yaht) = object marker

**isso** (his-soh) = struck

**tuk** (tohk) = past tense marker

**mafo** (mah-foh) = grandfather

**yvt** (yaht) = subject marker

**illi** (ihl-lih) = dead cha (chah) = and

**bvshli** (bahsh-lih) = cut

**hokmi** (hohk-mih) = burn

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
