Verb: **chekusi** – quickly, soon

**Ulla pvt sinti hilha chekusi ikhvna tuk.**

This child learned the snake dance quickly.

**Hattak mvt chekusi anumpuli tuk.**

That man was quick to speak.

## Word Meaning:

**tuk** (tohk) = past tense

**pvt** (path) = this/these

**sinti** (sehn-ti) = snake

**hilha** (he-tha) = dance

**chekusi** (chi-koh-see) = quickly

**mvt** (maht) = that/those

**vlla** (ahl-la) = child

**ikhvna** (eh-kah-nah) = learn

**hattak** (haht-tahk) = man

**anumpuli** (ah-nohm-poh-le) = to speak
