Vocabulary: **iti bʊsha** – lumber, board, a sawn board

Iti bʊsha chompa cha aiimpa ikba cḥi.

He will buy lumber and make a table.

Iti bʊsha ya cḥi chompa la hinla.

I will buy the lumber for you.

Word Meaning:

iti bʊsha (ih-tih bah-shah) = lumber, board, a sawn board

chompa (chohm-pah) = buy/purchase

cha (chah) = and

aiimpa (eye-ehm-pah) = table

ikba (ihk-bah) = to make

cḥi (chehn) = future tense marker

ya (yahn) = object marker
