

Lesson of The Day

Verbs: yaiya/yaya = cry

Ulla mvt yaiya.

That child is crying.

Ish yaiya tuk o?

Did you cry?

Word Meaning:

ulla (ahl-la) = child **mvt** (maht) = that/those

yaiya/yaya (ya-yah) = cry **ish** (esh) = you

tuk (tohk) = past tense marker

ho (h^onh) = question marker (*for question markers that follow a consonant the **O** form is used*)
