Word Meaning:

<mark>shukha nipi</mark> (shohk-ha ni-pi) = pork

okla (ohk-la)= they/people

hattak (haht-tahk) = man

vpa (ah-pa) = to eat (food item named)

bvnna (bahn-na) = want/need

pvt (paht) = subject marker (this)

palvska champuli (pa-lahs-ka chahm-poh-lih) = cake
