Vocabulary: **himitthoa** – young (of two or more), young people, young animals

**Himitthoa yvt Chahta anumpa ikhvna ya pi bvnna.**

We want the young people to learn the Choctaw language.

**Onna ninak a pim aiitvnaha himitthoa yvt taloa chi.**

Tomorrow night our church youth will sing.

## Word Meaning:

**himitthoa** (hih-miht-toh-wah) = young (of two or more) young people, young animals

**yvt** (yaht) = subject marker

**ninak** (nih-nahk) = night

**Chahta** (chah-tah) = Choctaw

**pim** (pihm) = our

**anumpa** (ah-nohm-pa) = language

**a** (ahn) = object marker

**ikhvna** (ih-kah-nah) = to learn

**taloa** (tah-loh-wah) = sing

**ya** (yahn) = object marker

**chi** (chehn) = future tense marker

**pi** (pih) = we

**aiitvnaha** (eye-iht-tah-nah-ha) = church

**bvnna** (bahn-nah) = want

**onna** (ohn-nah) = tomorrow
