## *Possessive Pronouns*

**pi** = his, hers, theirs, its -nasal form, prefixed before words that begin with a consonant.

**pim** = his, hers, theirs, its -m form, prefixed before words that begin with a vowel.

**Pi holisso apisa yvt chito fehna.**

Our school is very big.

**Pi holbattoba ish pisa chi ho?**

Will or Are you going to look at our pictures?

Word Meaning:

**pi** (p<sup>h</sup>hn) = our    **holisso apisa** (ho-lis-so ah-pi-sa) = school

**yvt** (yaht) = subject marker    **ish** (esh) = you

**chito** (che-to) = big    **holbattoba** (hol-bat-to-ba) = picture

**fehna** (feh-na) = very    **ho** (h<sup>o</sup>hn) = question marker

**pisa** (pi-sa) = see; look    **achi** (ah-ch<sup>h</sup>hn) = future tense

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
