Vocabulary: *vlwusha* – to be fried

Ahe vlwusha sv bunna.

I want fried potatoes.

Akaka vlwusha chompa chi.

He will buy fried chicken.

Word Meaning: **sv** (sah) = I

bunna (bahn-nah) = want/need

ahe (ah-he) = potatoes

vlwusha (ahl-wah-shah) = to be fried

akaka (ah-kahn-kah) = chicken

chompa (chohm-pa) = to buy/purchase

achi (ah-chehn) = future tense marker
