Vocabulary: okcha – to awake

Ull^osi yvt okcha.

The baby is awake.

Ulla mvt na yukpa hosh okcha.

That child wakes up happily.

Word Meaning: **vlla** (ahl-lah) = child

vll^osi (ahl-lohn-sih) = baby

yvt (yaht) = subject marker

okcha (ohk-cha) = to awake

mvt (maht) = that/those

na yukpa (nah yohk-pa) = happy

hosh (hohsh) = adverb marker
