PastTime Marker: -ash/-kash

Chekusikash impa li tuk.

I ate a little while ago.

Miko yvt chekusikash anumpuli tuk.

The chief spoke a little while ago.

Word Meaning:

chekusikash (cheh-koh-sek-ash) = a little while

impa (ehm-pah) = eat **miko** (m^ohn-koh) = chief

tuk (tohk) = past tense marker

yvt (yaht) = subject marker **li** (le) = I

anumpuli (ah-nohm-poh-le) = speak
