Body parts 'haknip' & 'sv'

'**Sv**' is a possessive personal pronoun that is used when one is referring to emotions, some family relationships and body parts. It can be translated as '**my**' and also '**I am**' when describing emotions or state of mind.

Sv haknip vt chunna.

My body is skinny.

Chi haknip vt chito.

Your body is big.

Word Meaning:

sv (sah) = my **haknip** (hak-nip) = body **chi** (che) = your

chunna (chun-na) = skinny **chito** (chi-to) = big

vt (aht) = subject marker
