

# Lesson of The Day

Fehna = Very

'**Sv**' is a possessive personal pronoun that is used when one is referring to emotions, some family relationships and body parts. It can be translated as '**my**' and also '**I am**' when describing emotions or state of mind.\*

**Sv na yukpa fehna tuk.**

I was very happy.

**Pilashash sv nukoa fehna tuk.**

I was very angry yesterday.

Word Meaning:

**sv** (sah) = my, I am (*see above*)\*

**tuk** (tohk) = past tense      **fehna** (feh-na) = very

**na yukpa** (na yohk-pa) = happy

**nukoa** (nohk-ko-wa) = angry

**pilashash** (pe-lash-ash) = yesterday
