Verbs: shali = carry

Pinak shali sv bvnna kiyo.

I don't want to carry the groceries.

Iti shali li tuk.

I carried the wood.

Word Meaning:

pinak (pi-nak) = groceries **sv** (sah) = I

bvnna (bahn-na) = want **shali** (sha-li) = carry

kiyo (ke-yo) = not (negator) **li** (le) = I

iti (i-te) = wood **tuk** (tohk) = past tense
