Adjective: iksho – absent; none; not any

Oka yvt iksho.

There is not water.

Holisso pisa yvt iksho.

The student is absent.

Word Meaning:

oka (o-kah) = water

yvt (yaht = subject marker

iksho (ik-sho) = absent; none; not any

holisso pisa (ho-lis-so pi-sah) = student
