

Lesson of The Day

Verb: ittahoba – gathered together
ittahobi – one who gathers

Illimpa ittahobi li.

I am gathering the food.

Okla yvt ittahoba tuk.

The people gathered.

Word Meaning:

illimpa (el-lehm-pah) = food

ittahoba (eht-tah-hoh-bah) = gathered together

ittahobi (eht-tah-hoh-bi) = one who gathers

li (le) = I **okla** (ohk-lah) = people

yvt (yaht) = subject marker

tuk (tohk) = past tense
