Nanta pisa hvchi bunna?

What do you all want to see?

Impa hvchi bunna?

Do you all want to eat?

Word Meaning:

nanta (nahn-tah) = what

pisa (peh-sah) = look/see

hvchi (hah-che) = you (all)

bunna (bahn-nah) = want

impa (em-pah) = eat
