Noun: nihi – seed(s)

Hushi mvt nihi vpa.

That bird is eating seeds.

Na pakanli nihi ish hokchi ho?

Are you planting flower seeds?

Word Meaning:

mvt (maht) = subject marker

hushi (ho-she) = bird **nihi** (ni-he) = seed(s)

ish (esh) = you **vpa** (ah-pah) eat

na pakanli (nah pah-kahn-le) = flower

ho (hoh) = question marker

hokchi (hohk-che) = plant(ing)
