Adverb: onnakma - tomorrow

Onnakma ish falama chi ho?

Will you return tomorrow?

Onnakma tumaha ia sv bunna.

I want to go to town tomorrow.

Word Meaning:

tumaha (tah-ma-ha) = town

ia (e-ya) = go **ish** (esh) = you

sv (sah) = I **bunna** (bahn-na) = want

onnakma (ohn-nak-ma) = tomorrow

falama (fa-la-ma) = to return/come back

chi (che) = future tense marker

ho (hoh) = question marker
