Verb: *falamv̄t* – return, come back

**Ulla m̄v̄t falamv̄t abeka.**

That child's illness has returned.

**Falamv̄t ish v̄la ch̄i h̄o?**

Will you be returning?

Word Meaning:

**v̄lla** (ahl-la) = child    **m̄v̄t** (maht) = subject marker

**falamv̄t** (fa-la-maht) = return, come back

**abeka** (ah-be-ka) = sick    **ch̄i** (che) = future tense

**h̄o** (hoh) = question marker

**ish** (esh) = you    **v̄la** (ah-la) = to arrive
