Verb: kopoli - bite

Isapuntak vt chi kopoli tuk o?

Did the mosquito bite you?

Chim ofi yvt vlla kopoli tuk o?

Did your dog bite the child?

Word Meaning:

ofi (o-fe) = dog **vlla** (ahl-la) = child

isapuntak (e-sah-pohn-tak) = mosquito

mut (maht) = subject marker (that)

ho (honh) = question marker **chi** (che) = you

kopoli (koh-poh-le) = bite **tuk** (tohk) = past tense

chim (chem.) = your **vt** (aht) = subject marker
